

Fall Heifer Validation:

Schedule a time with Angela or Spencer to validate your heifer 903-675-6130

Heifer Validation - \$15 per heifer due at validation. Make sure you bring your original registration papers to the Extension office to be scanned before validation. You can scan and email them to Angela as long as it is in color to achemphill@ag.tamu.edu.

If you have already validated your heifer and ownership has not changed, it does not have to be validated again. We will hold another heifer validation in October for those showing in spring majors.



STATE FAIR BROILERS

If you would like to show broilers at the State Fair of Texas, please let the Extension office know by Friday June 21st by calling 903-675-6130 or emailing Angela achemphill@ag.tamu.edu. Chicks are \$1.50 each with a minimum order of 25 and maximum order of 75. Only 2 pens can be entered by one exhibitor.

The date for the State Fair broiler show is Monday, September 30th. Entries will be due to the Extension office by August 19th. The birds will be picked up from A&M on Friday, August 16th. If we have enough families order, we can arrange for one person to them up. If not, you may be responsible for picking up your broilers from Texas A&M in College Station.
