2019 Major Show Heifer Validation

Heifers that are to be shown at a major show must be validated if they have not been already. This includes those heifers who may substituted later. Validation will occur October 22nd from 5-7 p.m. at Ken McGee's Cattle Pens (4272 CR 4706, Athens). Major shows include Houston, San Antonio, Ft. Worth, Rodeo Austin. Validation will include taking a hair sample for DNA testing and recording brands and/or tattoos. Cost is \$15 per heifer.

- Original registration papers must be brought in before validation date to be scanned at the Extension office.
- If you think you may show a heifer, then it has to be validated or it is not eligible.
- Major show scramble heifers also have to be validated
