Dear Producers,

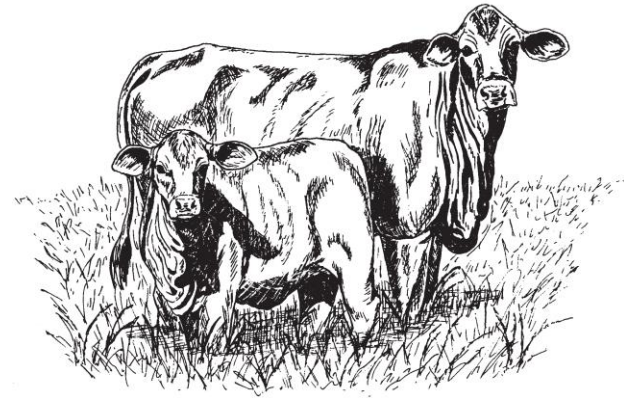
