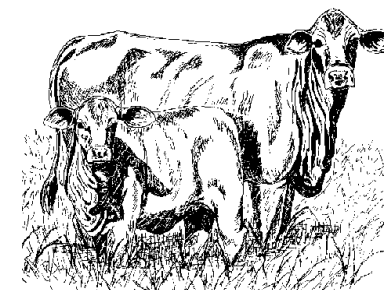
Dear Producers,
